## LINKLATER VOICE INTENSIVE

Kristin Linklater's vocal progression offers a thorough and comprehensive approach to strengthening and developing the actor's voice - one that can connect viscerally with language, transform expression of text and meet the demands of character.

**This five-day workshop is for experienced actors ready to refresh and deepen the connection to their voice in an immersive setting.**

What you can expect:

- An exploration of physical release, connection to breath and vibration, releasing and opening the channel for maximum expressive capacity
- Concentrated time to develop greater resonance, build breath capacity, enhance vocal flexibility and range, and energise articulation
- An introduction to linking voice work to text through a series of vocal exercises
- An immersive environment that will provide space to eliminate the physical and psychological blocks that inhibit the voice, so that the voice is in direct contact with emotional impulse.

Participants are asked to have 8 - 10 lines of text to use in various exercises throughout the week.

**Amy Hume** is a Voice Tutor at the National Institute of Dramatic Art (NIDA), Voice and Accents Tutor at Australian Theatre for Young People (ATYP) and Founder of leading voice and drama studio, Viva Voice. She is a Designated Linklater Teacher and also draws on the work of Cicely Berry, Patsy Rodenburg, Barbara Houseman, and other leading voice practitioners.

She is currently Voice Coach on the new ABC/Netflix TV series *The Unlisted*. Amy was Dialect Coach for Ensemble Theatre's *The Norman Conquests*, *Shirley Valentine* and *The Kitchen Sink*. She was also Dialect Coach for *Sami in Paradise* and provided voice support on *The Rover* and *Ghosts* (all Belvoir). Other theatre credits include Voice/Dialect Coach at the Sydney production of *Matilda the Musical* (RSC/Louise Withers), Voice Coach for *Measure for Measure* and *The Servant of Two Masters* (Sport for Jove), and Dialect Coach for *Stones in his Pockets* (Critical Stages). In New York she has worked on productions with Shakespeare & Co, The Shakespeare Forum and Columbia Stages.
